This course is approved by SafeWork NSW.

Prior to the course students must provide their USI (Unique Student Identifier <https://www.usi.gov.au>) and must undertake a Language, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment.

Practical component is held off site. Own transport is preferable.

On the day, students must bring 100 points of ID (the combination of documents presented to the SafeWork NSW accredited assessor must include your date of birth, current NSW residential address, photograph and signature).

You also need to bring a notepad and pen.

The practical component requires students must wear a broadbrim hat/safety helmet, long drill pants, yellow long sleeve hi-vis shirt and safety boots. Work gloves and safety glasses recommended for live site assessments.

A current White Card is required for all practical elements on a live site.
